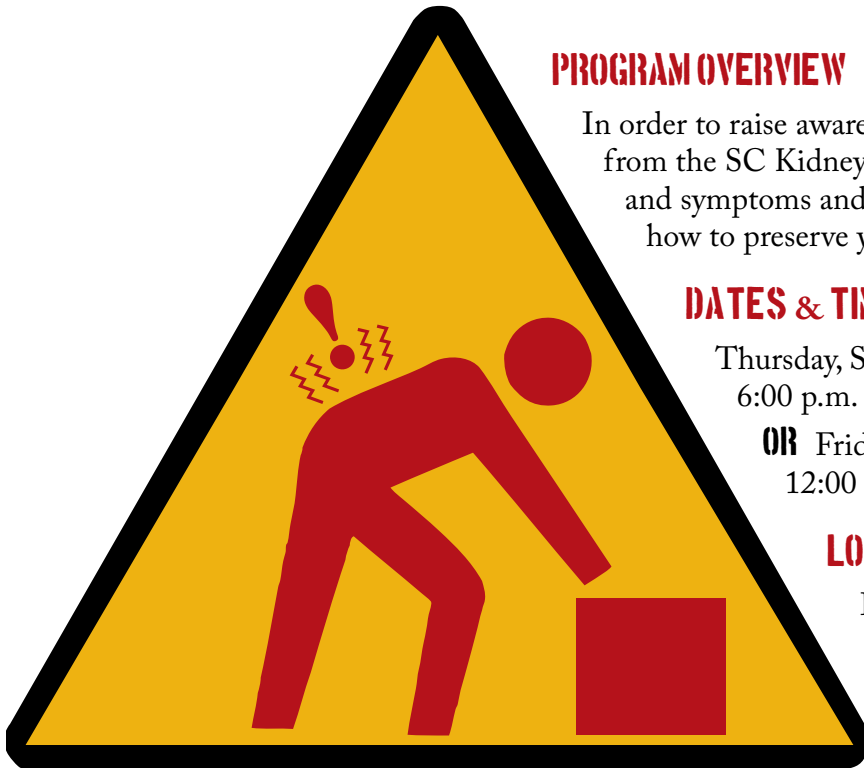


TAKE CAUTION » KIDNEY DISEASE «
