Medicare does not cover reimbursement for most vascular screenings. Insurance claims will not be filed through this screening program. Cash, checks or credit cards are accepted.

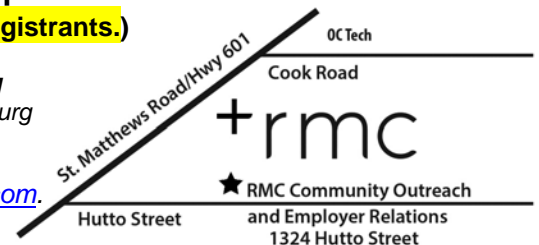

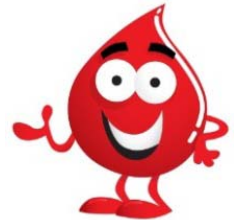
