The **Red Cord Program** is an innovative partnership between area high schools/colleges and the Blood Assurance Program at the Regional Medical Center. Its primary objectives are to:

- ◆ Nurture within young people a lifetime commitment to provide a safe and adequate blood supply to the local community;
- ◆ Provide recognition to participating schools;
- ◆ Provide valuable volunteer experience; and
- ◆ Be a source for community involvement and school pride.

To become a **Red Cord Hero**:

- ◆ **Donate blood three (3) times between August 17, 2018 and May 17, 2019** to receive a **Red Cord** before graduation.



*Underclassmen: Not graduating this year? Not a problem! You may fulfill the requirements for Red Cord Heroes this year even though you will not be graduating in 2019. You can even accumulate more than one (1) red cord to wear when it is your time to shine. \*Students ages 16 and 17 must have a signed parental consent form for a first time donation.*
