RMC's Vascular Center is offering three painless, noninvasive screenings: Carotid Arteries Scan, which checks for plaque in the major arteries; Abdominal Aorta Scan, which checks for bulging (aneurysm) in main artery; and Ankle Brachial Index, which checks blood flow in the legs. Medicare does not reimburse for most vascular screenings. Insurance claims will not be filed through this screening program. Cash, checks or credit cards are accepted.
